- Are you able to donate food for our trainees? Often our young people come from disadvantaged backgrounds. Being able to offer food when they are with us really helps with their participation.

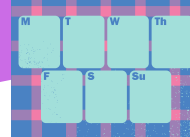

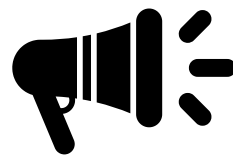

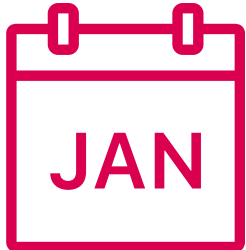
